OTHER PRODUCT NOTES: FENIX 12 mm are layers of melamine resin saturated paper combined with layers of acrylic resins and pressed under high temperatures of 300 deg F and pressures. The monomers and polymers react to cross link into a thermoset resin system. The residuals are a very small fraction of the unreacted monomers and are less than 7.3 parts per billion under the Greenguard testing program listed in this HPD
