More specifically, It covers 3 plies wood core flooring pre-finished at Toronto's facility in Ontario, Canada. The product is made of real hardwood boards with SPF quarter sawn core and a wood backing. Boards have uniform thicknesses and widths with micro-V joints on all four sides. The product is radiant heat approved for most wood species.

Adhesives A, D, G, H and I are used interchangeably to bond the hardwood lamella to the SPF core. The use of adhesives A, D, G, H or I depends on the wood species and flooring specs. Adhesives C, E, F, G and H are used interchangeably to bond the veneer backing to the SPF core. Special Conditions materials are present in the product: biological material, reaction products, defined substances without identifier, plastics and polymers. Guidelines for reporting Biological Materials (SCBioMats/2018-02-23) was followed. Other Special Conditions materials are still under development by HPDC and the manufacturer will update the HPD accordingly once these guidelines get published.
