Use of Special Condition - No CAS# Available: The Bay Resource Group models, which are covered under this

current HPD, contain an additive chemical in which a CAS# was not able to be determined for. The component "PVC Wear Layer" contains an additive ingredient identified by the manufacturer as an "Environmental Stabilizer" that is present in the final product formulation at a maximum of 0.41 % (4,000 ppm). The HPDC Approved Preparer worked with the supplier of the PVC Wear Layer and it was determined that a CAS# is not available for the environmental stabilizer additive. Therefore, the HPDC Approved Preparer has concluded that the Safety Data Sheet (SDS) published on March 13, 2015 for the PVC Wear Layer, that contains the environmental stabilizer ingredient, is compliant with the Commission Regulation (EU) No 2015/830 (EU CLP) and that no GHS Category 1 hazards are disclosed on the SDS., therefore, no HPD target hazards would be flagged for this ingredient.
